Background

In June 2016 we received funding of € 9,891 from Electric Aid for the construction of 2 new classrooms at Kisuri Primary School in Kenya.

Project Report

Facilities achieved:

• 2 new 30ft x 25ft classrooms

Community contribution:

- some building materials (murram and rough stone)
- volunteer labour for digging foundations
- paid some labour costs

Following receipt of the ElectricAid funds, we raised further funds from other donors to undertake further urgent works at the school. In total we were therefore able to provide: 2 new classrooms (funded by ElectricAid), the renovation of 5 existing unfinished classrooms, a block of latrines, and 2 rainwater catchment tanks (funded by other donors).

Anticipated Outcomes of This Project:

- We estimate that in the first year alone, 100 children will benefit from a greatly improved learning environment. With future intakes of children over the life of the buildings thousands of children will benefit.
- The capacity of primary education at the school has been significantly increased enabling more children to receive an education in less crowded conditions.
- Improved facilities will increase academic performance. Many will be given improved life opportunities, including increasing the number of primary school children entering secondary education.
